Our host will be Butch Martin, Shift Manager, NAV Canada Air Control Tower.

He will give us a tour of the Flight control centre and then give us a quick overview of what we have seen. Due to the sensitivity of the area we have been asked to split our group into 3 smaller groups.

NOTE: The Edmonton Area Control Centre is also the Western Region Area Control Centre responsible for all aircraft movements over Alberta and most of northern Canada, including the high Arctic. It provides both radar and non-radar Instrument Flight Rules (IFR) control service to all aircraft operating in controlled airspace, and to aircraft operating under Visual Flight Rules (VFR) with 24 hour service.
